

STREAM PLANNER – Salary Range \$38,322.00 to \$42,685.00 annually based on credentials. Duties include Coordinating and facilitating all efforts between the Delaware County Soil & Water Conservation District (DCSWCD) and Delaware County Planning Department (DCPD) related to stream management issues; working with DCSWCD in updating and administering the West and East Branch Delaware River Stream Corridor Management Plans; working with Town Planning Boards, Village Planning Boards and DCPD to implement the East Branch Delaware River and West Branch Delaware River Stream Corridor Management Plans goals and objectives; Liaise with county agencies involved with stream corridor issues including but not limited to the departments of: Public Works, Emergency Services and Watershed Affairs; liaise with the appropriate regional agencies to assist in the implementation of the Stream Corridor Management Plan including but not limited to: State Emergency Management Office, Delaware County Emergency Management Committee, New York State Department of State and Southern Tier East Regional Planning and Development Board; attendance at project review and planning meetings that pertain to stream management objectives; assisting with comprehensive stream corridor management education and outreach to county and local planning boards and the general public; facilitating and assisting with education and outreach to existing watershed associations and other similar organizations to incorporate stream corridor management and if warranted assisting in the formation of new watershed associations; providing guidance and assistance to towns and villages and local code officials to address floodplain management issues as they relate to stream management including flood insurance planning and administration.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from a regionally accredited New York State registered college or university with a minimum of a bachelor's degree in planning; OR graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a minimum of a bachelor's degree related to planning or environmental science and one (1) year of full-time paid or part-time paid equivalent experience in municipal, community or regional planning or related work; OR an equivalent combination of training and experience as indicated in A and B above.
